- 7. What was one surprising fact you learned about Kotlik from the film?
- 8. What would you like to bring from this documentary into your own life?
- 9. How does a village like Kotlik survive without immediate access to a hospital or local police?
- 10. How do you think the environment and culture of Kotlik are different from the students' home in California?
- 11. What are some of the challenges the Carlsbad students faced when they arrived in Kotlik?
- 12. How does learning about the Yupik culture help the Carlsbad students understand the world differently?
