- 6. How does learning about the Yupik culture help the Carlsbad students understand the world differently?
- 7. Why do you think the Kotlik school is such an important place in the village?
- 8. How do the traditions of hunting, fishing, and making traditional clothing contribute to the villagers' way of life?
- 9. What are some of the ways the Kotlik students and the Carlsbad students are similar? How are they different?
- 10. How do you think the experience in Kotlik helped the Carlsbad students become better storytellers?
- 11. What role do the elders of Kotlik play in teaching the local students about their heritage? Why is this important?
- 12. Why do you think the Carlsbad students described the kids in Kotlik as happy despite living in a very different environment?
- 13. What might have been some of the most memorable experiences for the Carlsbad students during Cultural Week in Kotlik?
- 14. How do you think the trip to Kotlik changed the Carlsbad students' perspective on the world?
